

Please note that Shri Vinod Chandra, Deputy Election Commissioner would interact with the DEOs & SPs and the Returning Officers of all the Assembly Constituencies in West Bengal under the following programme

For every programme the following format would be followed:

- A. Introductory interaction of the DEC with the DEOs and ROs for half an hour to be followed by continued interaction with the ROs only which would be coordinated by the ECI team.
- B. Separate meeting of the DEC with respective DEO and SP in a different room (each district taken separately)
- C. After the second meeting is over, DEC joins back the interaction with the ROs and does the debriefing.

Since we have already conducted one round of exhaustive training for the returning Officers and they have been provided with detailed reading materials, it is expected that by the time of the scheduled interaction they would be totally thorough about different processes and the stipulations. A test questionnaire would also be administered during the interaction for the ROs to respond to.

The host districts would make all arrangements including arrangements for accommodation for the representatives from the participating districts. From the ECI the DEC would be accompanied by a couple of senior Officers. The State team would comprise the CEO, Joint CEO and another Officer for each of the meetings. For Siliguri interaction, the State team would reach on 5th afternoon, and the ECI team would reach on 6th morning.

The District Magistrates and the Additional District Magistrates of the North Bengal Districts are also requested to attend a review meeting to be taken by the CEO, WB on 6 February from 9 AM to 12 Noon at Hotel Sinclairs, Siliguri.





Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to Section 159 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, which deals with requisitioning of staff for election work. It has been provided that the authorities mentioned in sub-section(2) of the said Section 159 shall make available to the Returning Officers such staff as may be necessary for the performance of any duty in connection with an election, on request made by the Chief Electoral Officer of the State.

2. The following authorities have been so specified under the said sub-section(2) of the section 159:

- (i) every local authority;
- (ii) every university established or incorporated by or under a Central, Provincial or State Act;
- (iii) a Government company as defined in section 617 of the Companies Act, 1956;
- (iv) any other institution, concern or undertaking which is established by or under a Central, Provincial or State Act, or which is controlled, or financed wholly or substantially by funds provided, directly or indirectly, by the Central Government or a State Government.

3. Section 26 of the Representation of People Act, 1951 empowers the District Election Officers to appoint Presiding Officers and Polling Officers for polling stations falling in his district. Further, under section 20A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the District Election Officer is required to coordinate and supervise all work in the District in connection with conduct of elections. Therefore, by convention and for convenience, the

District Election Officers have been requisitioning staff for conduct of election under Section 159 of the R. P. Act, 1951.

4. During the general election to the Legislative Assembly of Maharashtra, in 2009, the orders of requisitioning of staff issued by the DEOs and Collectors, of Thane district and Mumbai sub-urban district were quashed by the Hon'ble Bombay High Court in Writ Petition Nos. 8052 of 2009, No. 8039 of 2009, No. 8089 of 2009, No. 8111 of 2009, on the ground that the action on the part of the DEOs in issuing of requisition orders by invoking sections 26 of R. P. Act, 1951 and 13AA of the R.P. Act, 1950, without giving due regard to the provisions of Section 159 of the R.P. Act, 1951 were improper. The Hon'ble High Court held that the power under Section 159 is of the Chief Electoral Officer, and the CEO should requisition the staff keeping in mind the guidelines issued by the Commission. The High Court has also made an observation that while requisitioning staff, all the organizations should be considered so that some institutions are not picked up selectively ignoring the fact that deployment of large number of staff from a few institutions would be likely to result in hardships in the business of such institutions.

5. The Hon'ble High Court further observed that the Chief Electoral Officer should issue legal and valid requisition orders under Section 159 of the R. P. Act, 1951, for requisitioning of staff from the organizations covered by section 159 of the R. P. Act, 1951 in accordance with the law.

A copy of the common order dated 25th September, 2009 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in W. P. Nos. 8052, 8039, 8089 and 8111 of 2009 is enclosed herewith.

6. In view of the above, it may be ensured that the orders for requisitioning staff for election work are issued by the Chief Electoral Officer under section 159(1) of R.P. Act, 1951, requesting the authorities mentioned in sub-section(2) of section 159 of Representation of the People Act, 1951 to make available to Returning Officer such staff as may be necessary for performance of duties in connection with elections. Appointments of staff so seconded to Returning Officer should, however, be made by the District Election Officer under Section 26 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

7. The following guidelines should be kept in mind:

- (a) Based on the availability of staff in the institutions covered under Section 159(2), and the requirement of staff, the staff may be requisitioned from such institutions.
- (b) The Commission has exempted certain offices/institutions for the purposes of election duty in view of the essential nature of duties/services discharged by the institutions. This should be kept in mind.
- (c) Employees of banks, LIC may be drafted on election duty to the minimum extent possible, only in a constituency where sufficient numbers of govt. employees are not available or in emergent circumstances such as strike etc. by the Govt. employees. Care should be taken to ensure that normal functioning of banks, LIC are not interrupted. Care should further be taken to ensure that minimum numbers of employees of such institutions is requisitioned so that the business of these institutions is not hampered.
8. It is reiterated that while requisitioning of the staff for conduct of future elections, their rank, salary etc. should be kept in mind while making appointment and assigning duties to them.
9. The instructions in the earlier letter No. 464/INST/2009/EPS, dated 30th December, 2009, shall be treated as superseded by the instructions in the present letter.
10. These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned.



In connection with ensuing General Elections to the West Bengal Legislative Assembly, 2011, I would like to say that Dispersal Centre, Reception Centre and Counting Centre should be finalized in advance. In this context, I am to request you to go through the following instructions of the Commission and bring to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance –

Dispersal Centre

4. Commission's letter No. 470/2008/EPS, dated 19.01.2009 regarding Counting of vote for General/Bye-election to the House of People/State Legislative Assembly-ensuring transparency (Download from Commission's website)
5. Commission's letter No. 470/2009/EPS, dated 15.05.2009 regarding Counting of Votes – set up of additional tables for counting of postal ballots as per necessity (Download from Commission's website)

The salient points are –

For Dispersal Centre

- Dispersal Centre should be in convenient place for polling personnel, preferably in District Headquarter or Sub-divisional town.
- Separate Hall should be set up for each Assembly Constituency in the Dispersal Centre, if it is not possible to set up of separate Dispersal Centre for each Assembly Constituency.
- It should be kept in mind that smooth departure of polling personnel to the polling stations is the most important event of the day and so, advance planning is a must.
- Facilities at Dispersal Centre - (i) Boarding of vehicles. (ii) Training space, (iii) For checking of EVM + material by polling parties. (iv) Facilitation centre for postal ballots. (v) Strong rooms for EVMs and storage of other material. (vi) Distribution Counter. (vii) Medical Aid. (viii) Basic amenities

For Reception Centre

- Venue of Reception Centre and Counting Centre should be in the same place.
- The DEO and RO shall review the arrangements made at reception centre personally and ensure that a system is in place for ensuring a hassle free handling of EVMs and other documents.
- Counters for receiving EVMs shall be set-up in such a manner that there is no crowding at the reception centre when the presiding officers and polling personnels hand over the EVMs and other documents. This can be ensured by setting up separate counters for handling specific numbers of polling stations.
- A separate special counter should be set up for receiving EVMs and other documents from the specific polling stations about which complaints had been received from political parties/ candidates during the course of polling; polling stations in which significant events such as

- Violent incidents, heated arguments with the polling personnel, clash between polling agents, break-down of EVMs reported and where the EVM replacement had taken place etc.
- Arrangements at reception centre - Lighting, drinking water, first aid and other medical facilities
- Transport arrangements should be in place

For Counting Centre

- Counting centre and reception centres should be same.
- Strong rooms and counting centres to be within same campus - Earmarking of rooms for AC
- Maximum two halls for one AC - Up to 8 tables, including RO/ARC, in a hall with approval of ECI
- Maximum 15 tables (including the table of RO).
- Large rooms can be divided into halls by temporary partitions
- Normally only one AC in one hall.
- There should be sufficient place for counting officials/agents, etc.,
- Each counting centre will have a distinct No. and each hall within counting centre have a distinct No.

In view of these, I am to request you to send a list of Dispersal Centres and Reception Centres to this office not later than 28.02.2011.

Secondly, in forwarding herewith a copy of Commission's letter No. 470/2009/EPSC, dated 22nd January, 2009, I am to request you to send two copies of the following not later than 04.03.2011.

- I. List of counting centres in the enclosed Annexure-I,

- III. Map of each Counting Centre, and
- IV. Map (indicating the location of counting centres) of Parliamentary Constituency(s) with assembly segments falling within it and the district or districts in which it is spread over.


Sir,

I am directed to state that the Commission has advised that the following action to be taken in case of malfunctioning of EVM during counting of votes during General Election/Bye-elections: -

- a. In case any Control Unit does not display result, it should be kept back inside its carrying case and then be kept in the Returning Officer's custody in the counting hall. Counting of votes in other machines should continue as usual.
- b. When counting of votes in other machines is complete, the Returning Officer and Observer should see whether the margin of votes between the first candidate and the runner up is more or less than the votes polled in the malfunctioned machine (s).
- c. In both the cases where the margin of votes is more or less than the total votes polled in the malfunctioned machine (s), the Returning Officer should try to retrieve the result from this machine, with the help of engineers of BEL/ECIL, using Auxiliary Display Unit (ADU) in the presence of candidates or their election agents. If the result can be retrieved by using an ADU, the result of the election can be declared accordingly. In such a case, the Returning Officer and Observer should send a detailed report to the Commission in the format mentioned at Annexure-A.
- d. In case it is not possible to retrieve the result from the malfunctioned machine even by using ADU, then the returning officer should try to retrieve the result from the machine by taking a print out of the result with the help of engineers of BEL/ECIL. If the result can be retrieved by using a printer, the result of the election can be declared accordingly. In such a case, also the Returning Officer and Observer should send a detailed report to the Commission in the format mentioned at Annexure-A.

- e. If the result from the malfunctioned machine can not be retrieved even by using printer, the matter should be referred by the Returning Officer to the Commission for its decision and action may be taken as per the direction of the Commission. In such a case, the Returning Officer and Observer should also send a detailed report to the Commission in the format mentioned at Annexure-B, where the margin of vote between the candidates having highest vote and the runner up is more than the votes polled in the malfunctioned EVM, and in Annexure – C where such margin is less. In no case the machine should be opened, or its outer or inner seals disturbed in any manner. There should be no attempt to repair the machine. Replacement of any parts of the EVM in the field level is strictly forbidden.
- f. After completion of counting, all the Control Units whether result has been retrieved from it or not should be kept back inside their respective carrying cases. The carrying cases should then be sealed once again. The Returning Officer and Observer should put their signatures on the seal. All candidates and their election agents should also be allowed to put their signature on the seal. The Control Unit should be then kept in the strong room (s).

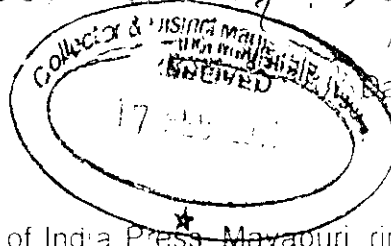

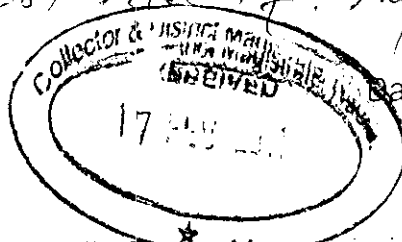


