

MEMORANDUM

In connection with the General Election to the West Bengal Legislative Assembly, 2011 to be held in phases as per the given schedule, the undersigned is directed to say that the State Government Employees who are ordinarily residents and bonafide voters of a Assembly Constituency where polling will be held but who are elsewhere in some other Assembly Constituencies where polling will not be held on the same day, may be given facility to exercise their franchise on the day of poll, if applied for in writing, by way of sanctioning the arrival at office or early departure therefrom or a short absence on that day subject to exigencies of Public Service. The State Government Employees who are residents and bonafide voters of a Assembly Constituency where polling will be held but employed in an office located at such a distance that it is not possible for them to exercise their franchise without absenting themselves from their offices may be allowed to receive casual leave on that day, if applied for by them.

The undersigned is further directed to say that as per the directive of the Election Commission of India, the day of dispatch i.e. the day before the Poll-day may be declared as a local holiday for the educational institutions located within the Assembly constituencies wherever necessary, if the day of dispatch happens to be a teaching day for those institutions.



Sir,

I am directed to refer to this office letter No. 1051-Home(Elec), dated 09.3.2011 on the subject mentioned above and to state that you were requested to deploy 8(eight) persons per district on the day of Commissioning of EVMs. Now, as the Returning Officers have arranged Second Randomization and Commissioning of EVMs schedule in such a manner that the entire process is to be completed within 3(three) days following the Commission's instructions in these regards. As there shall be mandatory mock Poll of 1000 Votes in respect of at least 10% of EVMs during Commissioning in each Assembly Constituency, entire planning should be carefully drawn up.
