TENDER NOTICE.

Sealed tenders are hereby invited by the undersigned from the bonafide and experienced contractors Registered Co-operative Societies formed by unemployed Engineers and Labour Co-operatives having credential of similar type of work and they have to abide by the following conditions:-

1. a) Application for tender paper should be submitted to the undersigned during office hours **upto 2.00 P.M. on 01.03.2011** along with **valid V.A.T, Income Tax, P.T.C.C., Trade Licence & credential (value will be calculated on the basis of actual expenditure mentioned in payment certificate of a single work)** That said credential value must be 40% or above of the estimated amount of work which is in this tender notice and in which the agency is interested.
b) In case of running work, work order and up to date payment certificate must be produced as above. The original documents will be returned after scrutiny and photocopy will be preserved by the undersigned. Payment certificate must be of last 05 (five) years of similar type of works done by the contractor. Partnership deed and other relevant papers (in case of registered Firm/ Company) should be produced at the time of application if required.
c) Cost of Tender Paper :- **See Annexure.**
2. Tenders papers will be issued to the qualified Contractors **within 02.03.2011 upto 2.00 P.M.** The u/s is not bound to issue to tender papers to all the applications. Decision of the undersigned regarding issue of tender papers is final.
3. Tender paper will have to be sent by Registered post or by courier service or by hand and it should reach the undersigned **within 2.00 P.M. on 05.03.2011.** Tender paper received after schedule time and date will not be entertained. It will be **opened on the same date** at the Office of the B.D.O. & E.O. **at 3.00 P.M.** or at any other date to be fixed thereafter. The intending tenderers may remain present at the time of opening of the offers.
4. Time is the essence of contract. The successful contractor must complete the work within the time specified for completion (see Annexure). No extension of time will be allowed expect in special case. If any contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated time the work order issued in his favour will be cancelled without assigning any reason there for. The undersigned may also proceed to get the balance work completed by any other means including through other contractors. The excess expenditure, if any due to such a step would be recoverable from unpaid bills/ security deposit of the tenderer. This is a part from any other penal measure the undersigned may take, including blacklisting of the contractors, forfeiture of earnest money.
5. Earnest money noted against the name of work @ 2% of the value of work will have to be deposited in the form of Bank Draft in favour of the undersigned. The earnest money will be converted in to security money after acceptance. Balance 8% security money will be deducted from the bill constituting 10% security money. The security money will be released as per norm. Engineers Co-Operative Societies will not be requited to deposit any earnest money.

6. The rate should be quoted in percentage both in figures as well as in words. If the offered rate is more than 15% (less) of the estimated amount, an analysis of the tendered amount would have to be provided during dropping of tender paper without having this analysis along with tender paper (more than 15% less) it may be rejected after opening of tender.
7. Incomplete tender will be rejected summarily. The successful tenderers will have to execute a formal agreement on a Non-judicial stamp worth Rs. 10=00 within 10 working days from the date of issue of work order.
8. Audit report of last financial year i.e. 2008-2009 and no objection certificate from ARCS will have to be submitted in case of Engg. Co-Op. & Labour Co-Op. Societies. The tender forms are to be received by the chairman or secretaries or any member of the society having proper power of Attorney. No Tender Form will be handed over to any outsider. Credential of similar type of works will have to be produced in case of Engg. Co-Op. & Labour Co-Operative.
9. All works will have to be done according to specification and drawing approved by the authority and as per direction of the Block Development Officer, Tehatta-I Dev. Block.
10. No consumable materials will be supplied to the agency for any work from the office of the undersigned. Agency will be responsible for procuring all materials required for proper execution of work at his own cost.
11. All rates shall be inclusive of all charges, Royalty, Toll charge, Carriage etc.
12. Before starting the work, the work site must be dressed and cleared by cutting all sorts of jungle, shrubs etc. For which no extra payment will be made.
13. Only 1 (one) tender form will be issued to each contractor for each work.
14. The contractors who will not submit tender paper or do not return the same before the date & time of dropping after receiving the same will not be allowed to participate in two consecutive tenders.
15. The successful tenderer will have to start the work within 7 (seven) days from the date of issue of work order after execution of formal agreement as per rule and will have to complete the work within the time allowed for completion.
16. Acceptance of the lowest tender is not obligatory and the undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason what so ever and also to split up the tendered work to more than one contractor in the interest of scheme execution.
17. Amalgamation of unemployed Engineers Co-Operative & Labour Co-Operative in any form should not be allowed towards counting of eligibility in participation of tender.
18. VAT/IT/Royalty/Cess at the prescribed rate will be deducted at source.
19. This notice shall form part of terms and conditions of tender & tenderer shall be bound to abide by them.
20. Before submission of the tender the contractor must visit the work site to judge the local condition from all corners and no plea/ complain about the site will be entertained afterwards. It will be presumed that the agency offered the tender after reviewing entire position of the work site.
21. a) Separate tenders should be submitted in similar way for each work or group of work. b) Before submitting tender the tender must got his signature attested on the contract Form by witness filling which his tender may be liable to be rejected.

22. All working tools & plants and implements required for the work are to be arranged and supplied by the successful tenderer, at his own cost.
23. The successful tenderer will have to abide by the provisions of West Bengal contract Labour Regulation & Abolition Rules, 1972 as will be force from time to time. If no Labour license is obtained and produced by the contractor payment will liable to be with held.
24. If the last date of submission of tenders declared as holiday, the tender will be received up to ----- hrs. and will be opened immediately afterwards as usual.
25. The tenders received after the due date and time and any change in quotation after opening of the tender will be out rightly rejected. The Department will not be responsible for the loss of tender from or for the delay in the postal transit.
26. Claim for idle labour from contractor will not be entertained under any circumstances. No claim will be entertained for any increase in railway freight and market price.
27. Bitumen will be supplied by the contractor with his own arrangement to submission of valid documents or I.O.C.
28. For construction of black top road , power roller of 8 to 10 ton, hand roller and miller mixture/spot mix plan of 3-5 ton/hour capacity must be arranged by the contractor on his own cost.
29. Tender is valid for 6 (six) months.
30. Work order will be issued only after availability of fund at this end.



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
